The Theatre Program at the University of Dayton is seeking an individual for the position of Costumer/Lecturer at the University of Dayton. This is a full-time non-tenure track, lecturer position starting August 2012.

Duties include serving as Costumer for mainstage Theatre Program shows each academic year in addition to teaching six credit hours each semester, which will include Introduction to Theatre. The Costumer/Lecturer will maintain costume workspaces and storage facilities and supervise and train student assistants as appropriate for each production, both in the assembly of costumes and the care of costumes through each run. Preference will be given to a qualified candidate who has taught and worked successfully with students from diverse backgrounds.

Minimum requirements include: MA or MFA; demonstrated ability to teach at the undergraduate college level; demonstrated ability to supervise and mentor undergraduate students and to organize and manage a theatre costume shop.
