**Preferred Qualifications:** Preference will be given to candidates with a background in modern dance design and functional skills with electronic media.

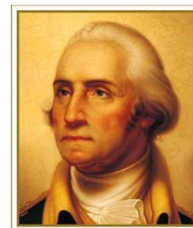
